Education: Davidson College (B.A., 1971); University of Mississippi (J.D. with honors, 1974).

David W. Mockbee is the president of Mockbee Hall & Drake, P.A. law firm in Jackson, Mississippi. David is an elected Fellow of the American College of Construction Lawyers and the American College of Trial Lawyers. David has been named the Jackson, Mississippi Construction Lawyer of the Year by Best Lawyers in America for the years 2011-2013. David has served for a number of years as General Counsel for the Mississippi Chapter of the American Subcontractors Association and has been an adjunct professor for the Mississippi State University School of Architecture since 1983 where he teaches "Legal Aspects of Architecture, Engineering and the Construction Process" to fifth year architecture students. His practice is limited to the representation of companies and firms in the construction industry, including architects, engineers, general contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers. David is also the author of Mississippi Construction Law (a 370-page treatise - 2nd edition -published in 2005), and he has also written numerous articles relating to construction and the law generally and has lectured frequently on the subject of construction law.

Ronald L. Lynn, Director/Building & Fire Official, has been with the Clark County Department of Building & Fire Prevention since February 1981. Mr. Lynn frequently lectures on a variety of topics, including department administration, legal aspects of building codes, finance and management, building codes, building performance standards, and construction issues.

Mr. Lynn's professional appointments and alliances range from local to international. He is Past President of the Board of Directors of the International Code Council (ICC), served as a member of the Board of Directors of the International Accreditation Service, and is currently on the Board of Managers for the International Evaluation Services. Additionally, he serves as Chairman for the following organizations: McCarran Airport Hazards Area Board of Adjustment; Nevada Earthquake Safety Council; and the Western States Seismic Policy Council's Architecture, Engineering and Construction Committee. He is also a member of the Nevada State Hazard Mitigation Planning Steering Committee, and the Nevada Bureau of Mines & Geology Advisory Committee. Mr. Lynn has also been appointed to the National Earthquake Hazards Reduction Program (NEHRP) Federal Advisory Committee on Earthquake Hazards Reduction (ACEHR) by the National Institute of Standards & Technology. In addition, the congressionally established National Institute of Building Science has appointed him to the Building Seismic Safety Council (BSSC).

In 2009, Mr. Lynn was recognized by the United States Congress for his contributions in building safety. In 2010, he received the Senatorial Commendation for his commitment to building safety, energy conservation, and emergency response. Further the Governor of Kentucky bestowed upon him the title of Kentucky Colonel for his continuing commitment to the built environment; and the Governor of Nevada declared December 9th as Ronald L. Lynn Day. In 2014, he was honored to receive the Community Achievement Award by the Asian American Group (AAG), the Government Person of the Year Award by the International Association of Plumbing & Mechanical Officials (IAPMO), and the 2014 Western States Seismic Policy Council Lifetime Achievement Award. In 2015, he received the International Code Council's highest award, the prestigious Bobby J. Fowler Award for his career of leadership in the building safety industry to achieve a safer built environment.
