

## Online Continuing Education for Architects

Most of the 55 U.S. jurisdictions require architects to complete continuing education courses as a condition for license renewal. Continuing education courses that provide qualified HSW learning units are available in many formats: conference seminars, lunch-n-learns, virtual education sessions, print/digital media, online courses, etc. Many jurisdictions allow a portion of, if not all, continuing education requirements courses from online learning. With conferences being cancelled and offices working remotely, many jurisdictions, who have had restrictions on online learning, have amended them to include this method of maintaining competency. Check your jurisdiction's requirements and updates to make sure you are meeting the responsibilities to maintain your license to practice architecture.
