3.	IDAC Report	<ul> <li>Mr. Cothron and IDAC members reported on activities of the IDAC and the Council for Interior Design Qualification (CIDQ). Highlights included: <ul> <li>An increase in the number of state certificate holders.</li> <li>More states have recently passed laws to regulate interior designers.</li> <li>Proposed governance changes were tabled at the 2023 CIDQ Annual Meeting.</li> <li>CIDQ is developing model legislation.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

"Tackle the Tape/29 by 29" Update	Mr. Cothron and Mr. Kilpatrick reported on the outcome of the Secretary of State's review of the BOA, LAAC, and IDAC rules and regulations, which resulted in two recommendations regarding design/build and responsible control requirements in the BOA rules. A response letter was sent to the Secretary explaining the purpose of the design/build requirements and requesting additional time to study revisions to the responsible control requirements.

6.	Board/Committee Member Orientation Refresher	Ms. Word presented a Board/Committee member orientation refresher, which included a review of the Board Member Code of Conduct, the Open Meetings Act, and the Public Records Act.
